Statement on Sabbath Services, Moral Conduct, Vegetarian Meals, the Possession and Use of Tobacco, Alcoholic Beverages and Drugs on Campus

The Mission of the Valley View University

The mission of Valley View University is to provide students, faculty, and staff with an environment conducive to a balanced development of the intellectual, spiritual, physical, and psycho-social dimensions of life in harmony with our Christian heritage and African culture. In a context of liberal arts and professional curricula, the University emphasizes academic scholarship, vocational preparation, and cultural understanding leading to a life of service to God and humanity.

In pursuit of this mission the University expects all applicants **who choose** to enroll in the Medical Equipment Technology Programme at the Valley View University to take note that:

- 1) The Valley View University cafeteria, like cafeterias in other Seventh-day Adventist-operated schools, colleges and universities throughout the world, serves only vegetarian meals. Scientists have found out that one lives a healthier life and possibly longer when on vegetarian diet – the ideal diet originally given to man by God in the Garden of Eden.
- 2) No coffee or tea is served in the cafeteria because these beverages are known to contain high levels of caffeine which is detrimental to human health.
- 3) The Valley View University campus is an “alcohol and drug-free campus”. All students are expected to abstain from possessing or using drugs and alcoholic beverages on campus. Smoking is also not allowed anywhere on the University campus.
- 4) The University encourages all students in residence to participate in the worship activities which are conducted during the Sabbath hours (i.e. from sunset Friday to sunset Saturday) as part of the University’s spiritual development programme.
- 5) The university expects all students to abstain from fornication and other immoral behaviour.

- 6) The University expects students to dress appropriately and in a manner that conforms to our Christian Lifestyle.
- 7) Failure on my part to abide by these and any other rules that may be announced or documented by the University authorities shall result in disciplinary sanctions against me.
